

Drive Safely on School Grounds! No Texting!

Dear members of our school family,

As always, the safety of our children is the primary concern. Therefore, closely follow the guidelines below to help ensure the safety of our students and staff members who assist with the flow of traffic before and after school. In addition, please share this information with anyone who may be picking up your child.

DROP OFF/PICK UP GUIDELINES

- There is a 5 M.P.H. Speed Limit when driving on school grounds.
- There is absolutely NO cell phone use or TEXTING permitted while driving on school grounds.
- During drop-off and pick-up times, pull as far forward as possible in the drop off/pick up lane and stay toward the right to enable cars to pass safely and to avoid blocking the traffic flow.
- Please release your child from your car to enter school at all points along the sidewalk in order to facilitate the flow of traffic. Do not wait until you reach the front door.
- Do not leave your car unattended in the traffic lane.
- Pick students up in designated drop-off and pick-up locations. The Cherry Valley loading zone is not for student drop-off since it is NOT a safe drop-off location. It is for employee use only.
- Load students only from the passenger side in the drop off/pick up lane.
- Minimize walking through the parking lot; please move directly to the sidewalk.
- If you are coming into the building near arrival and dismissal, you must park your car in an available parking space in the parking lot.
- Do not pick up students in the parking lot.
- Pay attention to your surroundings and follow the directions from staff members.
- Please enter by the traffic light on Stewart Avenue and exit past the flag pole on Cherry Valley Avenue.
- Only right turns are permitted when exiting on Cherry Valley Avenue.
- To further assist with the safety of the students, please be patient and respectful of each other including our staff supervisors. Thank you for your cooperation in helping to keep everyone safe.
