



SCOPE Education Services **DAILY PROGRAM SCHEDULE**

Welcome (10 minutes)

When the children arrive at the program, they are greeted with a warm welcome by SCOPE employees as attendance is being taken. Each student receives a personal hello and asked how they are feeling and how their day was.

* OCFS Health Check regulation is completed.

Snack Time*/Sharing Time (approx.30 minutes)

Time to sit down with our friends and have a healthy snack! During this time SCOPE shares important information for the day, as well as giving students the opportunity to share their thoughts, ideas and stories with their friends.

*SCOPE follows all OCFS regulations in washing hands before and after snack

Fitness Five (5 minutes)

A five minute fitness time break to stretch not only our bodies, but our minds too.

Homework Time (45 minutes)

SCOPE provides 45 minutes of homework assistance in a quiet and supervised environment. Whether it's a science project, spelling test, reading assignment or book report, the SCOPE staff support your child in completing their homework. If students complete their homework early, they will have quiet activities to choose from. Additional quiet/homework time will be incorporated into their day upon request.

Fitness Five (5 minutes)

A five minute fitness break to stretch not only our bodies, but our minds too.

Enrichment Time (approx. 45 minutes)

During this time students will be participating in various activities depending upon the day. Activities include:

STEAM Activities (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math) – Students have the freedom to discover, create, think, build and design.

Character Development Activities - Children learn all about being kind and empathic. They also learn about being part of a community and how we can help the community around us.

Creative Expression - Students will get to express their creativity through music, movement, dance and the visual arts

Literacy Activities - Students will discover a love for writing, reading and will learn about different genres.

Club Days - Students will have the opportunity to participate in various club offerings, depending upon interest. Examples: Drama Club, Chess Club, Fashion Design Club, Community Club, Comic Strip Club, Cultural Diversity Club, to name a few. At SCOPE we encourage the children to express their interests and design their own program club.

Special Events/Presenters - SCOPE plans special events throughout the year for students and parents. Whether the students are working on a talent show, a special Mother's Day Tea, fashion show or basketball game, parents are always invited to these special events. In addition, throughout the year, SCOPE will have special presenters come to the programs. Presentations range from the local fire department talking about safety to interactive instrument/music story tellers to an on-site planetarium. For the 2018-2019 school year, high school clubs/students will be part of our enrichment time, sharing their passion and knowledge to the younger students.

Physical Fitness Time (approx. 30 minutes)

Weather permitting the students will participate in organized physical fitness activities to promote sportsmanship, health, fitness and well-being. All physical activities are designed to improve attention span, memory, learning and reduce stress. Organized sports activities are designed to promote agility, endurance and strength building in addition to improving social skills through communication, cooperation and leadership. Activities include: yoga, parachute time, obstacle courses, bean bag toss, jump rope, kick ball, etc. On inclement days, children will participate in physical fitness activities in the gym.

Free Play /Child's Choice (approx. 30 minutes)

Allowing children to choose what they love most, keeps children excited to learn. During Free Play/Child's Choice time, SCOPE provides choices of art and craft materials, board games, puzzles, challenging brain teasers, educational games, checkers, chess, books, music and fitness equipment for children to learn, play and explore on their own while being closely supervised by SCOPE staff.
