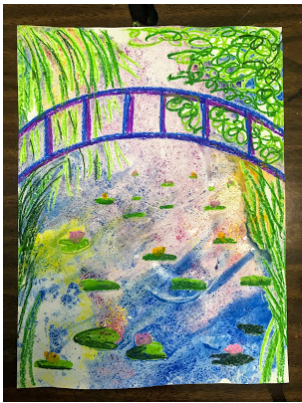

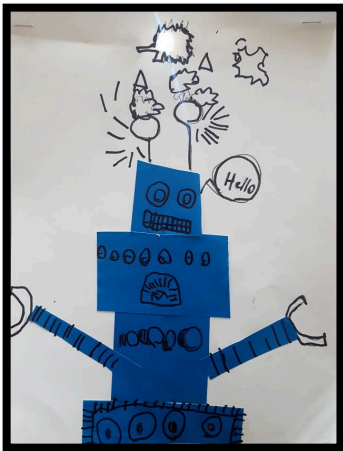
Kindergarten: *Monet Floating Chalk Prints*

Kindergarten artists are beginning to learn the elements of art and the special tools artists use to make a masterpiece. Our artists are studying the work of French Impressionist painter, Claude Monet. Perfect for the beginning of the season of spring! Students are learning about Impressionist artists, cool colors, and how to create the Impressionist mark through the use of oil and chalk pastels!



First Grade: *Chibitronic Robot Collage*

Our first grade artists will be exploring the area of STEAM within their next project, combining the areas of science, technology, engineering, art and math. Taking inspiration from the children's book *The Bot That Scott Built* by Kim Norman, students will be designing their own robot through the medium of collage. To bring their robots to life, we will be using sticker LED lights, copper tape, and a disc battery to create a circuit to illuminate our robots' antennas!

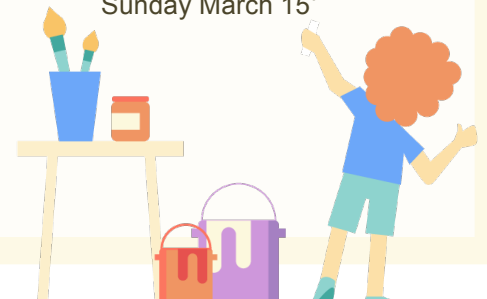
