3.) COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

Class Work: It is expected for class work to be neat, organized, and dated in Spanish. Binders will be checked at the end of every quarter.

Participation: Try your best to practice and communicate in Spanish on a daily basis. I will base your participation grade on the effort you put forth in communicating in class everyday.

Homework: Homework will be assigned on a regular basis. You will be required to copy your homework assignment in your school planner in class each day. (5 points will be deducted from the homework average for each missing homework assignment.)

*Refer to homework on the web if you have any questions. **Please be advised that homework posted on the web is subject to change.

*Also note, should there be an inconsistency between what was written in class (on the board) for homework and what is written on the web, please be advised that what is written on the board in class prevails.

Tests, Quizzes, Projects: Assessments will **always** be announced well in advance. Plan ahead and study a little each day. (I cannot stress this enough!)

**Please do not wait until the day before the assessment to study.

PLEASE NOTE

****The Honors Criteria for students entering 9th Grade (Spanish II) at Garden City High School is as follows:**

At the end of the third quarter, when third quarter grades and midterm grades / departmental assessments are final,

8th grade students must have:

**-an overall average of 92% or higher AND a midterm exam / departmental assessment score of 90% or higher
(Where there is no midterm / departmental assessment score, the class average will be the sole criterion.)**

Students with a class average of 90% - 91.99% will be reviewed for honors placement using an established skills set. The department will conduct the review and submit a recommendation for placement. The review will be held during quarter three.
