Dear Garden City School Community,

We learned close to the end of the day today that a student from Garden City Middle School tested positive for COVID-19. The student was not in school today. The Department of Health was notified and our internal contact tracing was completed a short while ago. Anyone considered as a possible close contact has been notified. School closure is not warranted at this time.

According to the guidelines from the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) and the Nassau County Department of Health, the individual who tested positive for COVID-19 will not be allowed to return to school for 10 days and all close contacts identified will be required to quarantine for 14 days.

Please continue to follow safety measures including wearing a mask, social distancing and practicing hand hygiene. We all want our schools to remain open.
