Dear Garden City School Community,

Since late yesterday and today, we have learned that three High School students have tested positive for COVID-19. The Department of Health was notified and our internal contact tracing was completed late this afternoon. Anyone considered as a possible close contact is in the process of being notified. School closure is not warranted at this time.

According to the guidelines from the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) and the Nassau County Department of Health, individuals who tested positive for COVID-19 will not be allowed to return to school for 10 days and all close contacts identified will be required to quarantine for 14 days.

Please continue to follow [safety measures](#) including wearing a mask, social distancing and practicing hand hygiene. We all want our schools to remain open.
